



Cleveland Air Magic – Uniform Policy

Intent of Policy - The policy is to ensure that Cleveland Air Magic Association (Inc) [hereafter referred to as CAM], provides a policy for members and associated members in relation to uniform requirements and regulations.

Uniform and Dress Requirements: Training Sessions

All skippers should wear neat, appropriate clothes that they can train safely in. CAM Training singlet is the preferred top to be worn by all skippers when training. We recommend a tank top or t-shirt and shorts or leggings.

Uniform and Dress Requirements: Competition and Performance Skippers

Skippers in the Competition and Performance Teams will require all items from the compulsory list of uniforms if they are competing or performing as representatives of CAM. No skipper will represent CAM without the full, correct, approved competition uniform. For competitions and performances, hair needs to be braided in two braids and then joined together. Glitter hairspray may also be worn.

Uniform and Dress Requirements: Recreation Skippers – Star Skippers

There are no compulsory uniform items for Star Skippers. CAM do offer an optional Star Skipper shirt that is encouraged to be worn for training or any CAM events that Star Skippers are invited to attend.

Uniform and Dress Requirements: Footwear

Supportive joggers must be worn at all times. No slip-on shoes, sandals, thongs or bare feet are allowed. Skippers without appropriate footwear will be asked to sit out for their own safety.

Uniform and Dress Requirements: Spectators

We encourage CAM parents and spectators to purchase CAM polos or CAM Cap to wear as support for the CAM club. The CAM polo and Cap are the ONLY CAM uniform item currently available for spectators to purchase and wear.



Guidelines:

To ensure consistency in colour, make and style, all uniform items must be ordered through the club from our preferred suppliers.

Orders for new uniforms will be placed at the start of each year, this will allow approx. 6-8 weeks for the order to arrive in time for any scheduled competitions.

Any additional orders throughout the year will be placed if quantities permit.

A uniform sizing/try-on option will be available at CAM Club pre-season sign on day. As our uniforms are custom orders, there is a NO return policy on incorrect purchases, unless the uniform is faulty or damaged. It is therefore recommended, that skippers attend sign on day to be sized correctly.

All uniform fees will be invoiced by CAM treasurer and are to be paid in full by the due date.

No uniforms will be issued to a skipper unless payment has been made in full.

The CAM uniform co-ordinator will facilitate any 2nd hand uniform sales within the club. All 2nd hand uniforms to be sold at 50% of original price.

Uniforms are to be kept in good repair.

Any changes to CAM Club uniform or Club colours must be approved by the CAM Executive Committee via the Uniform Co-ordinator before proceeding with any changes. This application shall be submitted via a drawing or sample of the proposed new uniform

Any changes to the existing CAM uniform generally allow 1 calendar year to changeover or as agreed by the CAM Executive committee at time of implementing the uniform change.

Any old style or expired uniform items are not to be worn by CAM members, parents or spectators as agreed by CAM Executive committee.

Only CAM Uniform Co-ordinator to liaise with CAM uniform suppliers, skippers are not to contact any suppliers directly, all enquiries are to go through the CAM Uniform Co-Ordinator.

Non-Compliance:

Any club member who breaches the Uniform policy will be reported to the committee and may face disciplinary action. Depending on the circumstances breaches of this policy may be dealt with in accordance with the disciplinary procedure contained in the CAM Constitution
