



# Alcohol and Drugs Policy

The purpose of this policy is to promote a safe, healthy, and inclusive environment for all participants, officials, volunteers, and spectators. Cleveland Air Magic recognises that the misuse of alcohol and drugs can negatively impact performance, safety, wellbeing, and the reputation of the sport and the club.

This policy applies to all members of Cleveland Air Magic, including athletes, coaches, officials, committee, volunteers, and spectators, during training, competitions, social events, travel, and any activity conducted under Cleveland Air Magic's name or affiliated parties.

## Alcohol

Alcohol consumption must comply with all relevant laws and regulations. Alcohol is prohibited at training sessions, club or affiliated events, and in change rooms, competition areas and location travel unless expressly permitted by the organisation. Where alcohol is served at approved events, it must be managed responsibly. Intoxication, binge drinking, or behaviour that compromises safety, performance, or respect for others will not be tolerated.

## Drugs

The use, possession, distribution, or sale of illegal drugs is strictly forbidden in association with the club. Members are required to refrain from participating in activities while under the influence of illegal substances or improperly used prescription or over-the-counter medications. The organisation upholds anti-doping regulations and expects strict adherence to all applicable sporting and legal standards. Athletes must meet all WADA obligations.

## Education and Support

The organisation is committed to education, prevention, and harm minimisation. Members will be encouraged to make informed choices and seek help when needed. Support and referral to appropriate services may be provided where concerns arise.

## Non-Compliance

Failure to adhere to the Alcohol and Drugs Policy may result in warnings, meetings with club officials, or other appropriate actions. The club has an obligation to report any illegal behaviour to the appropriate authorities.

The club reserves the right to take further measures if non-compliance continues.
