



Uniform Policy

This uniform policy for Cleveland Air Magic (CAM), ensures that all members present a cohesive and professional appearance during all club-related activities. Adhering to this policy helps to foster team spirit, equality, a sense of belonging and pride among all members. By adhering to these guidelines, we can ensure that our club is represented in the best possible manner, both on and off the field.

All members are required to wear the same style and design of the uniform to maintain uniformity.

No skipper will represent CAM without the full, correct, approved competition uniform.

To ensure consistency in colour, make and style, all uniform items must be ordered through the club from preferred suppliers.

Any changes to the existing CAM uniform, committee aim to allow 1 calendar year to changeover or as agreed by the CAM Executive committee at time of implementing the uniform change.

Any old style or expired uniform items are not to be worn by CAM members, parents or spectators as agreed by CAM Executive committee.

Only CAM Uniform Co-ordinator to liaise with CAM uniform suppliers, skippers are not to contact any suppliers directly, all enquiries are to go through the CAM Uniform Co-Ordinator.

All uniform items are to be clearly labelled.

Representing Skipping Australia (Ropearoos) or Competing Internationally as a club Athlete

When representing Team Australia, CAM athletes are required to comply with the uniform regulations established by Skipping Australia. Athletes must wear the full Team Australia uniform at all times, as any breach of this policy may bring CAM into disrepute.

Competitions and Performance Events - Uniform and Dress Requirements

Skippers in the Competition and Performance Teams will require all items from the compulsory list of uniforms if they are competing or performing as representatives of CAM.

Skippers are required to wear full CAM tracksuit when representing CAM on the podium and hair is to always remain braided. No caps permitted on the podium

Skippers are to ensure there are no visible bra straps showing.

Training Sessions: Uniform and Dress Requirements

All skippers should wear neat, appropriate clothes that they can train safely in. CAM Training singlet is the preferred top to be worn by all skippers when training. We recommend a tank top or t-shirt and shorts or leggings.

Star Skippers / Adult Skippers: Uniform and Dress Requirements

There are no compulsory uniform items for Star Skippers. CAM do offer an optional Star Skipper shirt that is encouraged to be worn for training or any CAM events that Star Skippers are invited to attend.

Uniform and Dress Requirements: Footwear – ALL skippers

Supportive joggers must be always worn. No slip-on shoes, crocs, sandals, thongs or bare feet are allowed. Skippers without appropriate footwear will be asked to sit out for their own safety.

Uniform and Dress Requirements: Spectators

We encourage CAM parents and spectators to purchase CAM polos, CAM cap, CAM hoodie or puffer jacket to wear as support for the CAM club. These items are the only items available to spectators to purchase and wear.

Uniform and Dress Requirements: Hair

For competitions and performances: hair needs to be braided in two braids and then joined together. Glitter hairspray may also be worn.

For training: hair needs to be pulled back and neat.

Uniform and Dress Requirements: Club Events and Functions

Members attending official club meetings or functions must wear the official club polo shirt or formal attire as specified by the club and the event organizers.

Uniform Orders and Payments

CAM Uniform pricelist is reviewed annually by committee

Orders for new uniforms will be placed at the start of each year; this will allow approx. 6-8 weeks for the order to arrive in time for any scheduled competitions.

Any additional orders throughout the year will be placed if quantities permit.

A uniform sizing/try-on option will be available at CAM Club pre-season sign on day. As club uniforms are custom orders, there is a NO return policy on incorrect purchases, unless the uniform is faulty or damaged. It is therefore recommended, that skippers attend sign on day to be sized correctly.

A 50% deposit is payable upon placing a uniform order. All remaining uniform fees will be invoiced by CAM treasurer and are to be paid in full by the due date.

No uniforms will be issued to a skipper unless payment has been made in full.

2nd CAM Hand Uniforms

CAM hosts a 2nd hand Facebook page that all members can access for the purpose of buying/selling 2nd hand uniforms, the club does not operate a formal 2nd hand uniform shop.

Parents/skippers can post available items with a description/price/photo and all members can access and liaise directly with the seller and decide regarding payments and delivery.

The Facebook page is administered by CAM committee and all members must adhere to Cleveland Air Magics social media policy at all times.

Committee and coaches request that any faded/damaged items NOT be posted or re-sold to maintain our clubs' high standards and ensure our skippers look their best and wear the CAM uniform with pride.

Committee recommend 2nd hand uniforms be sold at 50% of original price as a guide.
